

## CIM Updates:

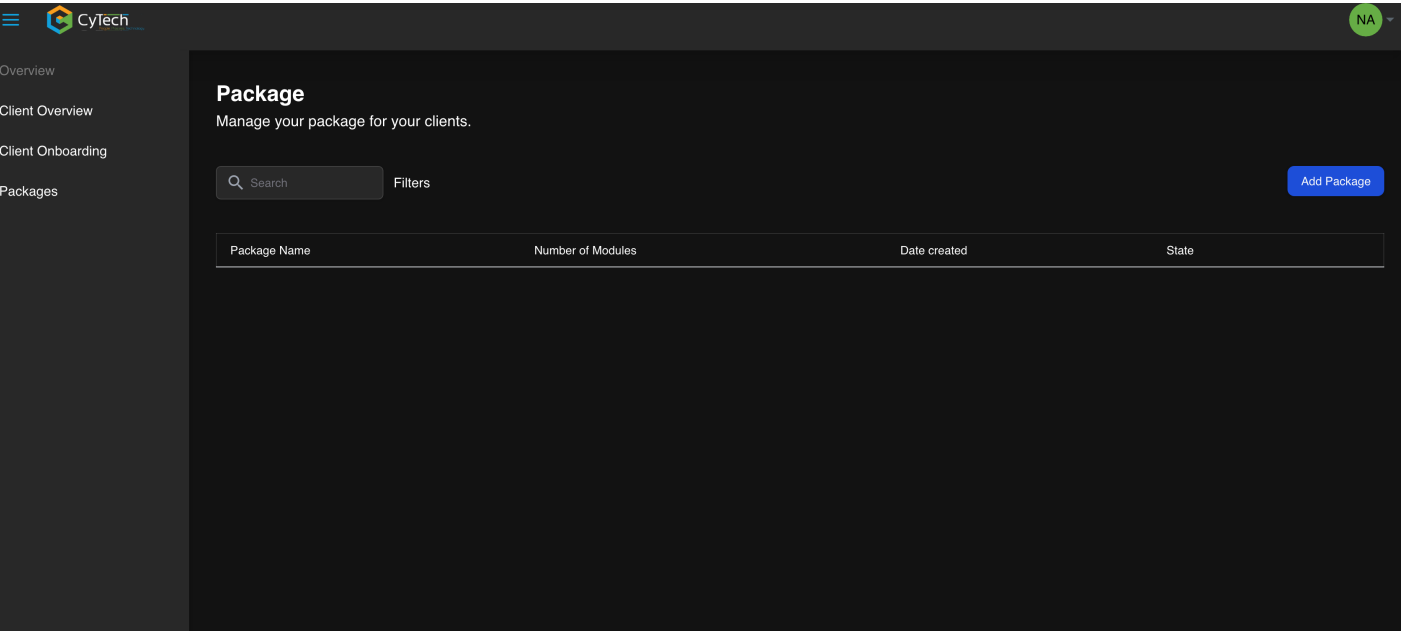
When log source is unhealthy, the reason can now be displayed
